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COVER LETTER

Dear members and friends of the IACP,

We report to you the IACP activities in 2020 and seek your continuous support in the future. The year 2020 has been turbulent and full of surprises. While we adjusted by holding the annual conference and the annual business meeting virtually, we also initiated many activities to serve the communities and to strive for our mission.

First, it is important to maintain communication and engagement with IACP members and friends. In addition to the annual newsletter, we also issue monthly newsletters which give updates on our activities more frequently. Additionally, we rely on the updated IACP website (http://www.china-planning.org/) and the IACP WeChat account (IACPforChinaPlanning) to reach out to a broader audience. In March 2020, when COVID-19 became a global pandemic, I issued a letter to share our reflection on IACP's roles in a time of uncertainty. All these communications are essential when in-person contacts are limited.

Second, although COVID forced us to change the format of the annual conference and annual business meeting, these online meetings allowed broader participation in IACP activities. IACP hosted the annual business meeting on November 4 (http:// www.china-planning.org/alpha/2020/12/25/businessmeeting-2020/). The board gave an update on our activities, presented the financial report, announced seven IACP awards, and called for membership. The 14th annual conference was postponed to December 5-13, 2020. During the nine days, we held the opening and closing ceremonies, 9 special sessions, and 53 parallel sessions, which altogether attracted close to 40,000 viewers online. Third, the current board continues the tradition of facilitating and disseminating China-related research in international journals. In 2020, we organized six special issues in journals of Urban Forestry & Urban Greening, Transportation Research Part D, Housing

我们向您报告IACP在2020年的活动并寻求您的继续支持。

在充满动荡与惊奇的2020年, 我们不仅成功举办了线上年会和线上业务会议, 并且发起了许多新活动以提供服务, 满足我们的使命。

首先,我们需要保持与IACP成员和朋友的沟通。除了年度新闻通讯,我们还发布每月新闻通讯,让会员与朋友了解IACP活动动态。此外,我们依靠新IACP网站(http://www.china-planning.org/)和IACP微信公众号(IACPforChinaPlanning)与更多参加者联系。 2020年3月,当COVID-19成为全球大流行病时,我写了一封信,分享我们对在不确定时期IACP角色的反思。当我们不能面对面联系的时候,这些沟通联系必不可少。

其次,尽管COVID迫使我们改变了年会和年度业务会议的模式,这些在线会议允许更多人参加到IACP活动中。IACP于11月4日举办了年度业务会议 (http://www.china-planning.org/alpha/2020/12/25/business-meeting-2020/),理事会总结IACP年度活动,提交财务报告,宣布七个IACP奖项,并呼吁大家成为日营,13日。在9天中,我们举行了开幕式和闭影式,9场特别会议和53场平行会议,总共吸引了近40,000名在线观众。就参加者而言,这是IACP迄今为止规模最大的年会。请在此处查看会议信息(http://www.china-planning.org/alpha/2020-conference-information/)。

第三,现任理事会继续促进和传播与中国规划相关的研究。 2020年,我们在Urban Forestry & Urban Greening, Transportation Research Part D, Housing Policy Debate, Travel Behaviour and Society, Socio-Ecological Practice Research, and Cities等期刊上组织了六期专刊 (http://www.china-planning.org/alpha/special-issues/)。我们为"可达

Policy Debate, Travel Behaviour and Society, Socio-Ecological Practice Research, and Cities (http://www.china-planning.org/alpha/special-issues/). We held two virtual symposiums based on the special issues of "Planning for Accessibility" and "High-Speed Rail and the Environment".

Fourth, the board initiated new activities for career and research development. For career information, we launched a new webpage (http:// www.china-planning.org/alpha/category/jobannouncement/) to share job announcements, hosted four six virtual job information sessions on urban planning, cohosted two sessions on public policies and administration, and organized three online roundtables where new faculty members shared job search experiences. To advance research, we organized one roundtable of "Grant Application and Tenure Promotion" and arranged two lectures on "How to Prepare a Literature Review" and "How to Propose a Good Research Ouestion". The second lecture event was live broadcasted with more than 10,000 participants. We also co-hosted a semester-long lecture series on Future Cities with Beijing Jiaotong University.

Looking forward, the inaugural IACP Academic Writing Workshop for Junior Urban Scholars, originally scheduled in June 2020, will be held in a hybrid format (Virtual+In-Person) on January 8-16, 2021 (http://www.china-planning.org/alpha/2020/12/21/writing-workshop-2020/). The 15th IACP annual conference will be hosted by Nanjing University and is tentatively scheduled for July 2021. Other activities, including special issues and online symposiums, are under development with IACP members and friends.

We feel that we have made concrete efforts to continue the great work of previous IACP boards. I wish to express sincere gratitude to you for your participation in IACP activities, and I hope you will continue supporting our organization. If you have not, consider becoming a member of IACP (http://www.china-planning.org/alpha/membership/).

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

THE 14TH IACP ANNUAL CONFERENCE WAS SUCCESSFULLY HELD VIRTUALLY IN DECEMBER 第十四届国际中国规划学会年会 12月5日-13日成功在线上举办

The 14th annual conference of the International Association for China Planning (IACP) was held virtually on December 05-13, 2020. The conference was organized by the IACP and hosted by the School of Architecture and Design at the Shenzhen University. The theme of this conference was "Urban Innovations in the New Planning Context." The nine-day online conference included nine special sessions and 53 parallel sessions, in addition to the opening and closing ceremonies. The conference was held online via TenCent Meeting and broadcasted at the Bilibili.com. Almost 300 faculty members, researchers, students and planners from around the world registered the conference. The conference received more than 40,000 online views.

大会开幕式于12月5日上午在深圳大学以线上线下结合的方式举行。深圳大学建筑和城市规划学院副院长杨晓春教授主持开幕式,深圳大学校长李清泉和IACP主席胡伶倩分别致辞。

The opening ceremony was held on December 05, 2020 as a mixture of online and in-person event at the Shenzhen University. Professor Xiaochun Yang, the Associate Dean of the School of Architecture and Urban Planning at the Shenzhen University, presided the opening ceremony. Dr. Qingquan Li, the President of the Shenzhen University, and Professor Lingqian Hu, the IACP chair, welcomed all participants to the conference and delivered their opening remarks.

This conference featured world-renowned speakers and public officials. Professor Zhiqiang Wu, an academician of the Chinese Academy of Engineering and vice-President of the Tongji University, gave his keynote speech on fast urbanization in China. Dr. Bing Zhang, Director of the Bureau of Territorial Planning of the Ministry of Natural Resources, gave his speech on territorial planning and sustainable development. Professor Christopher Webster, the Dean of the School of Architecture at the Hong Kong University, gave his keynote speech on smart cities.

The nine special sessions were held on three days. Professor Xiaochun Yang chaired a special session on contemporary urban planning theory and trend of thought. The special sessions on December 6th highlighted four topics. Professor Xinyue Ye and Linggian Hu organized a panel that discussed planning for future built environment; Professor Jiayan Liu led a panel discussion of creating cities of sharing through planning; Professor Li Tian organized a special session on enhancing the market-based allocation of land factors and its implications for territorial spatial planning; and Professor Zhengdong Huang moderated a session on mega-city region and synergy of urban cluster. The five special sessions on December 12th discussed reglobalization (organized by Professor Yifei Sun), urban informality (organized by Professor Lei Zhang), urban renewal in Shenzhen (sponsored by the Peking University-Lincoln Institute Center and moderated by Dr. Zhi Liu), and space syntax of urban good life (organized by Professor Haofeng Wang).

大会特别论坛的第一场在12月5日下午举行,杨 晓春教授主持. 论坛主要探讨当代规划理论与 思潮以及深圳的经验。四场特别论坛在12月6日 举行。叶信岳和胡伶倩教授共同主持特别论坛 探讨规划未来城市空间; 刘佳燕教授主持由《 城市规划》(英文版)组织的特别论坛、探讨 共享城市规划: 田莉教授主持关于土地要素市 场化与国土空间规划实施的特别论坛; 黄正东 教授主持特别论坛探讨超大城市区域与城市群 协同。最后四场特别论坛在12月12日举行。孙 一飞教授主持关于再全球化的特别论坛; 张磊 教授主持特别论坛探讨城市非正规性: 北大林 肯中心主任刘志主持关于深圳城市更新研究的 特别论坛; 王浩锋教授主持关于城市空间句法 与美好城市生活的特别论坛。

200多位教授、研究生以及规划师在53个平行论坛和圆桌论坛中作报告。报告主题范围广泛,覆盖城市规划的主要领域,包括城市交通与基础设施规划、住房与社区发展、城市健康与安全、城市更新与历史保护、城市与景观设计、用地与经济发展、环境规划、城市大数据分析以及规划教育。

大会与三个国际学术期刊合作出版特别期刊。 刘志林教授担任Housing Policy Debate杂志特 刊编辑;关成贺教授担任Travel Behavior and Society杂志特刊编辑;仲浩天教授担任Socio-Ecological Practice Research杂志特刊编辑。

大会闭幕式由杨晓春教授和胡伶倩教授共同主持。美国规划院校联合会候任主席拉克斯米· 拉玛苏布拉曼尼亚教授做关于未来全球规划 教育的演讲。美国弗吉尼亚理工大学副校长 More than 200 faculty members, researchers, and students presented their research in 53 parallel sessions and roundtables. The 53 parallel sessions and roundtables covered a wide range of research topics in the fields of transportation and infrastructure planning, housing and community development, urban health and safety, urban renewal and historical preservation, urban and landscape design, land use and economic development, environmental planning, urban analytics, and planning education.

The conference sponsored three special issues of academic journals: Housing Policy Debate (Professor Zhilin Liu as the guest editor), Travel Behavior and Society (Professor Chenghe Guan as the guest editor) and Socio-Ecological Practice Research (Professor Haoting Zhong as the guest editor).





Dr. Laxmi Ramasubramanian, the president-elect of ACSP, gave her keynote speech on the future of global planning education. Dr. Daniel (Dianzhi) Sui, the vice-President of Virginia Tech, gave his keynote speech on urban innovation in the post-pandemic period. Professor Xiaoguang Wang, chair of the IACP Award Committee, announced seven awards. Dr. Julia Harten, an assistant professor at the University of British Columbia, won the ACSP/IACP Karen R. Polenske Best Student Paper Award; Mr. Sicheng Wang, a Ph.D. candidate at the Rutgers University, won the Karen R. Polenske Best Student Paper Award; Mr. Hengyu Gu, a Ph.D. student at the Peking University, won the IACP Best Student Paper Award; Dr. Li Fang, an assistant professor at the Florida State University, won the IACP Rising Scholar Award; Dr. Zhi Liu, Director of the Peking University – Lincoln Institute Center, won the IACP Distinguished Service Award, Xuanyi Nie (a graduate student at the Harvard University) and Hengyu Gu (Shanghai Academy of Social Science) won the Economic Approach in Urban Sustainability Studies Award, and more than a dozen presenters won the IACP Presentation Award.

After the award ceremony, Professor Lingqian Hu announced that the 2021 IACP annual conference will be held at the Nanjing University. Dr. Xiaolong Luo, the Associate Dean of the School of Architecture and Urban Planning at the Nanjing University, greeted the audience and encourage them to attend the next year's IACP conference in Nanjiing. In the end, Professor Xiaochun Yang announced the successful conclusion of the 2020 annual conference.


The International Association for China Planning (IACP) successfully hosted its business meeting online on November 4, 2020. More than 50 scholars across globe attended the meeting.

ACADEMIC WRITING WORKSHOP FOR JUNIOR URBAN SCHOLARS (VIRTUAL MEETING)

IACP城市研究青年学者学术写作与发表工作坊 (线上会议)

The first academic writing and publishing workshop for young scholars in urban studies, co-sponsored by the International Association for China Planning (IACP) and the School of Public Administration, Tsinghua University, will be held in the form of a web conference from January 9-16, 2021. This workshop is dedicated to improving the academic writing and publication level of young Chinese scholars in urban research and related fields, cultivating young scholars in the field of urban planning and governance in China, and providing a platform for learning, exhibition and exchanges for the majority of academic young talents.

The conference invited 8 editors-in-chief and associate editors of journals related to urban planning and urban research to provide detailed guidance on the writing and publication strategies of academic papers by young scholars. The content will include: conference lectures on academic writing, publication and professional development of young scholars, as well as one-on-one exchanges with the editors of top international journals in group seminars. Among them, the opening and closing ceremonies and conference lectures will be broadcast live on the Bilibili platform (live link: https://live.bilibili.com/22307441); group discussions are limited to internal exchanges between participating scholars and will not be made public.

The main working language of this workshop is English.

The future city lecture series of Beijing Jiaotong University——Urban spatial structure and travel in China 北京交通大学未来城市系列讲座—— "城市空间结构和出行"总结

The series of lectures have been completed, focusing on indepth discussions on theories, methods, data, and practice of frontier urban problems. The course is not only to expand students' interest in urban transportation research, but also to help them understand the decision-making process of urban transportation planning, and apply it in their own research and dissertations.

The course is divided into four modules, including theoretical review, common research methods, data acquisition and analysis, practice and application. Each module enables students to master the basic ideas and methods of urban transportation research through specific thematic research and the advantages and limitations of each analysis method. These lectures focus on topics related to urban job-housing relationships, transportation and land use, accessibility and urban rail transit. Research projects discusses in the lecture series are examples for students to understand diverse methodologies, explain the findings, and provide recommendations for urban transportation policies.

Before joining NYU Shanghai, Dr. Guan worked as a postdoc at the School of Engineering and Applied Sciences and a Harold A. Pollman Research Fellow of Real Estate and Urban Development, both at Harvard University and also as a consultant to the World Bank. He received his master's and doctoral degrees from the Department of Urban Planning and Design, Harvard University. He has won awards from multiple academic institutions: Best urban planning award from the Urban Land Institute (ULI); Annual paper award from the American Association of Geographers (AAG); Award for the most innovative design from the American Institute of Architects (AIA); and Karen R. Polenske best paper award from the Association of Collegiate Schools of Planning (ACSP). He is also the recipient of the Pujiang Scholar grant from the Science and Technology Commission of Shanghai.

Shaopeng Zhong

Dr. Shaopeng Zhong is an associate professor in School of Transportation and Logistics at Dalian University of Technology and the Deputy Director of the Traffic Engineering Laboratory. He is a visiting scholar in urban and regional planning at University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (2008-2010). He is a guest professor at
