Dear members and friends of the IACP.

We report to you the IACP activities in 2021 and seek your continuous support in the future. In 2021, the IACP launched several activities to serve the communities and to strive for our mission.

In October 2021, IACP successfully transitioned the leadership of the Board of Directors. The new leadership of the IACP for the years 2021-2023 is made up of five newly elected Board of Directors and eight incumbent Directors. As the new Chair of the IACP Board, I sincerely thank the five outgoing Board of Directors (Lingqian Hu, Yiping Fang, ChengHe Guan, Siqi Zheng, and Xiaoguang Wang) for the leadership, hard work, and commitment they provided to the IACP. I am excited to work with the Board members to continue and enhance IACP' s achievement in the last 15 years.

Along with our local host the Nanjing University, IACP successfully hosted the 15th Annual Conference virtually on September 10-12, 2021. We held the opening and closing ceremonies, three special sessions, and 57 parallel sessions for three days. More than 300 faculty, researchers, and graduate students attended the conference from more than ten countries around the world. IACP organized a writing workshop for junior urban scholars in a hybrid format (virtual + in-person) in the school of Public Policy and Management at the Tsinghua University (China) on January 9-16, 2021. The workshop included nine former and current editors of seven well-read journals in the fields of urban studies and planning, such as Urban Studies, Journal of the American Planning Association, and Journal of Planning Education and Research. IACP hosted the annual business meeting on October 8, 2021. Dr. Lingqian Hu, the outgoing Chair of the Board of Directors, reported IACP activities of the past two years to the Advisory Committee and IACP members. The board also updated the financial report, announced several IACP awards, and called for membership. At the meeting, the IACP Board of Directors officially transferred its leadership. In fall 2021, IACP initiated the Job Search and Career Development Workshop Series. As of December 2021, we had successfully organized four workshops. Five junior faculty and researchers discussed their experiences on academic job markets in the first workshop. In the second and third workshops, eight faculty members from the United States, Europe, Australia, and Asia advised about job application preparation and interview from the search committee's perspectives. The fourth workshop included three faculty members in China to share their experiences in applying for research grants from the National Science Foundation China.

IACP continued our tradition of facilitating and disseminating China-related research in international journals. In 2021, we organized special issues in journals of Urban Forestry & Urban Greening and Sustainability (http://www.china-planning.org/alpha/special-issues/).

Looking to the future, the 16th IACP annual conference will be hosted by the Huazhong University of Science and Technology (China) and is tentatively scheduled for June 2022. The Job Search and Career Development Workshop series will continue in spring 2022. A few other activities are under discussion and development. The new board believes that we have gotten off to a solid start and that we will build on the excellent work of past IACP boards. I wish to express sincere gratitude

THE 15TH INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR CHINA PLAN-NING (IACP) CONFERENCE SUMMARY 第十五届国际中国规划学会(IACP 2021) 年会总结

On September 11, 2021, the 15th IACP Conference was officially held online. The conference theme was "Territorial Space Planning in the Context of New Globalization and Regionalization". The local host was the College of Architecture and Urban Planning at Nanjing University with co-organization support by the Urban-Rural Management and Policy Research Academic Committee of the Urban Planning Society of China. Member of the Standing Committee of the Party Committee of Nanjing University, Executive Vice President Prof. Tan Zhemin, the Chair of IACP Prof. Lingqian Hu from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, and Secretary of the Party Committee in the College of Archi-



tecture and Urban Planning at Nanjing University Yian Zhou, attended the opening ceremony and delivered speeches. Nearly 500 scholars, experts, and planners -domestic and overseas - in urban and rural planning and other related fields participated in the conference. The meeting was also broadcast live on the Blibli plat-

2021 IACP Business Meeting

2021国际中国规划学会商务会议

The International Association for China Planning (IACP) successfully hosted its business meeting online on October 8, 2021. More than 80 scholars from across the globe attended the meeting.

In the beginning, Prof. Marlon Bornet (University of Southern California), president of the Association of Collegiate Schools of Planning (ACSP), and Prof. Laxmi Ramasubramanian (San Jos é State University), president-elect of ACSP, gave the opening remarks for this meeting. After that, Prof. Linggian Hu (University of Wisconsin, Milwaukee), outgoing chair of the IACP Board of Directors, introduced IACP's key goals and summarized key activities organized in 2020 and 2021. These activities included the 14th and 15th IACP Annual Conferences, the writing workshop for junior urban scholars, six job information sessions, three job market experience round tables, two academic writing seminars, and the career development round table. In addition, IACP also hosted two lecture series in collaboration with other organizations: the World Transport Convention and the China Highway Transportation and Society. Additionally, IACP sponsored three journal special issues. Prof. Jige Quan (Seoul National University) announced the winners of the six IACP awards. Prof. Hongwei Dong (California State University, Fresno), chair-elect and conference committee chair, introduced the new IACP Board of Directors (2021-2023). Prof. Junfeng Jiao (University of Texas, Austin), the treasurer, gave a financial report of IACP in 2021 and invited scholars to join IACP as members. Finally, all attendees discussed several issues pertinent to IACP, including how to serve the planning scholars both in and outside China during the pandemic and how to continue efficient academic communication in the new global environment.

ACADEMIC WRITING WORKSHOP FOR JUNIOR URBAN SCHOLARS WAS SUCCESSFULLY HELD ONLINE 城市研究青年学者学术写作在线研讨会成功举行

The Inaugural IACP Academic Writing Workshop for Junior Urban Scholars, co-hosted by IACP and the School of Public Policy and Management, Tsinghua University, was successfully held online on January 9-16, 2021.

The workshop aimed to improve the writing skills of junior scholars of urban planning and related fields, cultivate young scholars through a platform for learning and knowledge exchange.

Eight editors lead the workshop, including Yingling Fan (University of Minnesota), Ann Forsyth (Harvard University), Cathy Yang Liu (Georgia State University), Kathe Newman (Rutgers University), Haifeng Qian (University of Iowa), Tom Sanchez (Virginia Tech), Michael Smart (Rutgers University), and Weiping Wu (Columbia University). The workshop attracted more than 80 applications. Eventually, 33 young scholars were accepted for participation, submitted their final manuscripts, and participated in the workshop.

The workshop includes two parts: whole-group lectures and small-group discussions. The three whole-group lectures were organized around three themes: academic writing strategies, journal publishing strategies, and career development. The editors shared their experiences from the perspectives of senior scholars and international journal editors. Young scholars gained a deeper understanding of academic writing, the process of paper submission, skills of academic publication, as well as the prospects of Chinese urban research from an international perspective. The whole-group lectures were broadcast live, attracting more than 33,000 online viewers.

The workshop also included small-group discussions,

首届IACP城市研究青年学者学术写作研讨会于2021年1月9日-16日以网络会议的形式成功举办。本次会议由国际中国规划学会(IACP)与清华大学公共管理学院联合举办。会议致力于通过建立一个学习和交流的平台,提升城市研究相关领域广大青年学者的学术写作水平。

八位学术期刊的主编参与了研讨会,包括范颖玲(明尼苏达大学),安·福赛斯(哈佛大学),刘阳(佐治亚州立大学),凯西·纽曼(罗格斯大学),钱海峰(爱荷华大学),汤姆·桑切斯(佛吉亚理工大学),麦克·斯玛特(罗格斯大学)和吴维平(哥伦比亚大学)。本次研讨会吸引了超过80名申请者。最终,33位青年学者入选本次研讨会,提交了他们的文章原稿,并全程参与了本次研讨会。

研讨会包括大会讲座与分组研讨两个部分。三场大会讲座分别围绕学术写作策略,期刊发表策略和青年学者职业发展规划三个主题展开。特邀主编从资深学者和国际期刊审稿人的视角分享他们的经验,使青年学者更加深入了解了学术写作,投稿流程,发表技巧,以及国际视角下中国城市研究的发展。大会讲座环节通过网络平台进行同步直播,累计吸引了超过3.3万人次在线观看。

本次研讨会还包括了小组讨论,与主编的一对一交流,和跨组讨论。根据文章主题,参会者被分成了四个小组:规划,建成环境和健康;城市管理和政策制定;城市活力,修复和行为;住房和社区管理。通过模拟审稿,小组讨论以及一对一交流,参会者提升了学术写作及发表水平,扩展了视野,并且提升了对学术研究的认同和对学术团体的认知。

one-on-one meetings with editors, and inter-group communications. Participants were divided into four thematic groups based on their submitted manuscripts: planning, building environment, and well-being; urban governance and policymaking; urban vitality, amenities, and behavior; housing and neighborhood governance. Through mock peer review, group discussions, and one-on-one meetings, workshop participants improved academic writing and publication skills, expanded their horizons, and enhanced their identification with academic research and recognition of academic communities.

In 2021, IACP organized four online workshops, among which three were about the academic job search, and one was about grant proposal writing.

On October 29th, IACP organized a workshop on overseas job search. This workshop was hosted by Xiang Yan (University of Florida), IACP Board Director. IACP invited five young scholars who recently joined overseas universities to share their experience on the job search. These scholars include Xinyu Fu (University of Waikato), Julia Harten (University of British Columbia), Kailai Wang (University of Houston), Sicheng Wang (Michigan State University), and Tianren Yang (University of Hong Kong). On November 6th and November 13th, IACP organized another two workshops on the overseas job search. For these two workshops, IACP invited senior scholars who have served as members of the search committee to share their experience on the job search. One workshop was hosted by Hongwei Dong (California State University, Fresno), Chair of IACP Board Directors, and included Zhenhua Chen (Ohio State University), Yan Liu (University of Queensland), Ming Zhang (University of Austin, Texas), and Pengyu Zhu (Hong Kong University of Science and Technology). The other workshop was hosted by Junfeng Jiao (University of Austin, Texas), IACP Board Director, and included Fei Chen (University of Liverpool), Xinhao Wang (University of Cincinnati), Xinyue Ye (Texas A&M University), and Li Yin (University at Buffalo). These three workshops attracted more than 200 participants.

On December 1st, IACP Young Scholar Committee organized a workshop on how to prepare proposals for the National Science Foundation of China (NSFC) for junior faculty members. IACP invited Na Ta (East China Normal University), Sisi Liang (Tsinghua University), and Wenchi
